Narrative Report Social Pension for Indigent Senior Citizens 2nd Quarter, 2014

Introduction :

For the 2nd quarter of CY-2014, the Social Pension has an additional staff hired to accommodate the demand on the increased number of social pensioners in the implementation of the program. The added staffs are the SWO-I, PDO-I and AA-IV and with this recent member of the team, the PSU Head conducted an emergency meeting to discuss matters relative to the roles and functions of each staff and the bayanihan support system of each member to comply the goals by providing the senior citizens with their pensions in earliest time for their augmentation in medicines, foods and other needs. Likewise, to provide thecnical assistance to the LGUs and comply the expected output for submission to central office.

During this quarter, the Regional Director with SOCPEN and NHTU staff visited different SWADT areas to meet and discuss with the NHTU Area Supervisors on the percentage of accomplishment on the on-going special enumeration of the non-nhts social pensioners. The Regional Director gave emphasis on the special needs of the elderly and she instructed the AS to fast track the conduct of assessment and immediately to submit the ready documents to Regional Office for the encoding and onward submission to Central Office for PMT assessment.

The result of the assessment on validation of the Non-NHTS were as follows; The total target for special validation is **6,752**. As of June 30, 2014, the total number assessed with family assessment form is **6,018** and about **89** % of accomplishment.

On this quarter, the RSP staffs were terribly busy on the updates of the ledger of accounts, processing of replacements, preparations of payrolls for selected areas of Zamboanga City and Sirawai, ZDN for the cash payout that was handled by the PSU due to some delays on the submission of liquidations. The RSP staff were also to managed and to processed the documents for downloading of funds to LGUs for the 2nd to 4th quarter for **16,754 NHTS Beneficiaries** only amounting to **Php 54,592,500.00**.

Moreso, during this quarter, the RSP staff with the PSB representative Ms. Lorna Mirasol facilitated a consultation dialogue among stakeholders on the proposed service providers as other scheme in the implementation of social pension. The participants are the MSWDOs, OSCA Head, FSCAP Officers and some service providers who are present in the municipalities of Sirawai, Siocon and Baliguian, Zamboanga del Norte.

Physical Accomplishment – As of ^{2nd} quarter of 2014, the non-nhts are still pending until further notice from the central office for the downloading of nhts-data base. The total number of non-nhts beneficiaries are 6,752 which are subject for PMT at the NHTO-Central Office.

Facilitating Factors

- > The augmentation of RSP staff helps a lot in the implementation of program.
- > The regular conduct of monitoring visits and consultation meeting with local government units helps in the speedy submission of liquidation report.
- The support generated from the Regional Director during the meeting with NHTU- special validation concerns were responded immediately.

Hindering Factors

- The blackout or electric backdown affects the encoding and printing of the payroll list and additional nhts validated list for approval of the Regional Director and other official transaction.
- There are some areas who cannot fully paid the beneficiaries during payout schedules due to rainy season.

Next Step

- Assist and respond to queries and concerns during LGUs payout in different cities and municipalities.
- To continuosly updates the ledger of accounts and the registry of beneficiaries of the 72 areas.
- Regular conduct of monitoring visits and to retrieve reports and liquidations.
- Preparation of documents for the 1st -2nd quarter of CY-2014 Transfer of Funds of the remaining balances of the non-nhts beneficiaries.
- To conduct consultation dialogue and forum with the LGU to introduce other scheme of payment for social pension and supplementary feeding program through service providers or other scheme that is applicable in the locality and
- With the completion of the validation for those not included in the NHTS before, it is hope that payment with this Social Pensioner can be done within this quarter.

Recommendations

For PSB to follow with NPMO to allocate funds for capital outlay for the office tables and chairs, desktop computers and augmentation funds for mobile expenses of the 3-additional staff and also for the PSB to update the Regional Office on the stustus of PMT Results of the Non-NHTS beneficairies.
