Brief Description of the Projects :

<b>KALAHI-CIDSS</b> - A community- driven development (CDD) initiative of the Department of Social Welfare & Development that aims to lessen poverty incidence, improve local governance, and implement local solutions to poverty issues in the community.	<b>Sustainable Livelihood Program (SLP)</b> - A community-based capacity building program that seeks to improve the program participants' socio-economic status. It is implemented through a two-track program : the Micro enterprise Development Task support micro-enterprise in becoming organizationally and economically viable while the Employment Facilitation Task assists participants to access appropriate employment opportunities.	<b>Pantawid Pamilya</b> - Provision of conditional cash assistance to extremely poor households to improve their health, nutrition and education particularly on children 0-14 years old.	<b>Social Pension</b> -Republic Act 9994 or the "Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010" which provides additional benefits and privileges and maximize their participation in nation building ameded the previous RA-9257 The Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2003", Institutionalizes social protection by providing monthly stipend to indigent Senior Citizens to augment the daily subsistence and other medical needs of the elderly and it is subject for review every two (2) years by Congress in consultation with DSWD. Provision of P500.00 monthly stipend to indigent senior citizens.	<b>Unconditional Cash Transfer (UCT)</b> also known as Tax Reform Cash Transfer Project is the biggest mitigating measure under TRAIN Law. The program will be implemented for 3 years with DSWD as the lead implementing agency giving provision of unconditional cash grants of P200 per mnth for year 2018 and P300 per month for year 2019 and 2020 to 10 M poor households.	<b>Supplementary Feeding Program (SFP)</b> - Provision of hot meals and rice per child aged 3-5 years old enrolled in Day Care Centers for 120 days	<b>Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS)</b> - Provision of integrated services such as provision of direct financial and material assistance to individuals and families in crisis or difficult situation to enable them to meet their rrequirements for food while in hospitals caring for sick persons or when travelling back to their home town/destination, transportation, medical, burial and education. Other assistance such as referrals for medical, legal, psychosocial, temporary shelter, and other services to walk-in and referral clients in crisis situation.	<b>SAP - Social Amelioration Program</b> for Indigent Families who are affected with GCQ brought about by COVID-19 pandemic.
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
